

General Grant Information, Instructions and Reminder Items

Background:

The Tuskegee Airmen Inc. Ohio Memorial Chapter is a unique organization dedicated to promoting the legacy of those Afro-American men and women who serve in the segregated Army-Air Corp from 1941-1949. Ever year the Chapter awards grants of **\$500.00** to deserving high school seniors. The grant award is based on the student's need, their service to the community, and their grade point average.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must be students of accredited high schools who have graduated or will be graduating in this year.

Applying students must have a minimum of 2.0 but no more than a maximum 2.99 Grade Point Average.

Application Procedures:

Application Forms may be obtained from the Tuskegee Airmen Inc. Ohio Memorial Chapter Members or downloaded via Tuskegeeairmenomc.com.

Each applicant must complete the entire application and provide all attachments listed on the bottom of the application form.

The applicant MUST include a single page essay on •How the Tuskegee Experience Parallels Your Life." Essays must be typed, double spaced with 1 inch margins on 8.5"X 11" paper.

Selection Procedures:

A grant selection committee will evaluate the applicants.

Applicants will be screened, verified as appropriate, and competitively evaluated.

The committee will consider academics, extracurricular and community activities, relative financial need, recommendations, and essay to competitively rank the applicants.

Notification & Award Procedure:

Award recipients will be notified by a TAI OMC Grant Committee. Notification of this year's Award Recipients will be made by June 1, 2021.

A check will be made out to the award recipient and mailed to the address on applicant record.
